





### NEVER FORGET: CHDS REMEMBERS 9/11





CHDS held a special [Alumni Hour webinar](#) on September 1, 2021. The hour and a half long session featured faculty guest Seth Jones; alum and FDNY Chief of Department, Tom Richardson; and NYPD Deputy Chief Joe Gallucci. The guests discussed how their departments have utilized lessons learned to evolve in the 20 years since 9/11 and the impact of events in Afghanistan on U.S. homeland security. This webinar was open to CHDS students, alumni, staff, and faculty.
