General Strategy Requirement for Navy FAOs

To broaden FAO education beyond a purely regionally focus, Navy FAO community leadership has directed that Navy FAO students in NSA degree programs must include at least one course addressing each of the following six strategic themes:

- I. Maritime Strategy and Operations
- 2. Political Economy
- 3. Information and Influence
- 4. Technology
- 5. Security Cooperation
- 6. Wargaming

This requirement may be satisfied by curricular core and elective courses, or by general electives. A single course may count for only one of the six themes, even if it is listed for more than one. The Wargaming requirement can be satisfied by taking the course listed below, or by experience in a wargaming exercise (with prior approval of the Navy FAO Chair).
